



## BO STEIBER IN THE Maldives and Singapore

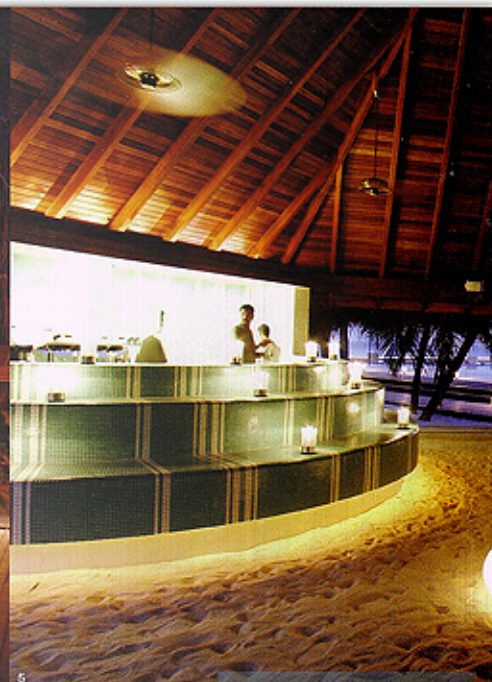


### HUVAFEN FUSHI RESORT, MALDIVES

A high end resort built on one of the many islands of Maldives in the surrounding island reef with its first underwater spa treatment rooms. The resort design is chic and contemporary with exclusive high end quality products in all facets, like 'retro' SMEG fridges with Avian mineral water located in public spaces

throughout the resort. Ulti lighting and curtain control system in all villas and exclusive custom-made light fixtures.

The resort architecture is built into the existing indigenous species of plants surrounding which allows the exterior space to flow through the interior through the openness of its buildings. The project provided the used of both artificial lighting and natural lighting to the architecture and interior. Similarly lighting is carried through from the external building and landscape into the interior buildings. The application of 2,400 end lit fibre-optics in the bottom of the swimming pool provides an exclusive in-pool dining



experience both under and 'above' the stars. The exclusivity of the Ocean and Beach Villas extends to its individual private pools. Both the Beach Bungalows and Ocean Villas are fitted with high end home theatre that comes with flat screen LCD television and surround sound system.

### ONE MARINA BOULEVARD, SINGAPORE

One Marina Boulevard is home to the National Trades Union Co-operatives Headquarters (NTUC) comprising 32 storeys of office space and basement with underground linkway to the Mass Rapid Transit (MRT). It is located at the prestigious location in the central business district at Raffles Quay.

The main lighting feature are two lanterns which also houses the NTUC logo. The lanterns are made up of a series of light boxes which are fitted with Colour Blast 12 LEDs from Color Kinetics which are providing a spectacular and an endless array of coloured displays on the Central Business District skyline. The linear lighting uses cold cathode which are concealed along the edges of the building gives an illusion of floating façade planes from certain angles along the East Coast Expressway. **●**
